

## Wrekinsport CC Competition Rules 2018

### General Competition Rules

C1	Definition of racing categories: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• A Junior shall be a member who has passed their 12th birthday and has not yet reached the 31st of December in the year in which their 18th birthday occurs</li><li>• A Senior shall be a member who has passed their 18th birthday and is not a Junior</li><li>• A Veteran shall be a member who has passed their 40th birthday</li></ul>
C2	The Club Committee shall have the final say how Trophies and Medals shall be awarded. This will be reviewed annually as a standing item in the last committee meeting before an AGM takes place. As the club develops, the methodology of awarding trophies may be updated according to current trends.
C3	Categories shall be Senior, Veterans, Junior and Women's. Women shall compete in their respective age categories for quickest and handicap.
C4	Members marshalling club events and helping run the event as pusher-off or timekeeper will be entered into a prize draw, awarded monthly during the racing season.
C5	All riders (except Juniors) competing in club 10's etc must marshal (i.e. turn marshal, time keep, pusher off etc) at least one event during the season. Failure to do so will result in any awards won being forfeited.
C6	No performances using the likes of E-bikes will be allowed

### Competitions won on Quickest Time

C7	Senior and Veteran's Best All Rounders shall be decided over 25 miles, 50 miles and 100 miles. Any Open event taking place in D (Liverpool) District or Open events promoted on any course by clubs belonging to Shropshire Cycling Clubs Association to count. Veteran's will be awarded on Actual, not Standard.
C8	Junior and Women's Best All Rounders shall be decided over 10 miles and 25 miles. Any Open event taking place in D (Liverpool) District or Open events promoted on any course by clubs belonging to Shropshire Cycling Clubs Association to count.
C9	50 and 100 mile championships shall be taken on the quickest time from any Open event at the distances taking place in D (Liverpool) District or Open events promoted on any course by clubs belonging to SCCA
C10	The 25 mile TT championship shall be awarded from a Wrekinsport event. If both an Open and a Club 25 are run the Open shall take priority. In the event of the club not running such an event, the Championship will be the SCCA 25 Championship event
C11	The Chris Edwards Trophy shall be won by the quickest first claim member in the club's Open Hilly 18
C12	The quickest time of the season recorded by a club member in the club's Evening 10 Series shall win the club's Fastest 10 Trophies in Senior, Junior and Women's categories
C13	The Hill Climb Trophy shall be won by the quickest 1st claim member in the Club's Hill Climb Championship.
C14	The John Cotton 4-Up Trophy shall be awarded to the quickest team of four fully comprised of 1st claim Wrekinsport members in the SCCA 4-Up Championship

### Competitions won on Handicap

C15	Handicaps will be based upon the difference between the quickest ride by any club member in the previous year's Evening 10 Series compared to each riders' quickest club 10 in the Series of that previous season (or their first of the new season if no event ridden in the previous year), rounded to the nearest 30 seconds. For Hanna Phipps-Jones and Gordon Davies events handicaps will be doubled due to the additional distance.
C16	Handicaps shall be used to award medals in the club's Hanna Phipps-Jones and Gordon Davies events. These will be run over a distance of 18-19 miles.
C17	The 2-Up TT competition shall be taken from the club's 2-Up event. It shall be awarded on handicap, using the average handicap of both team members.

C18	The 10 mile Handicap Trophy shall be awarded to the rider recording the quickest actual time of the season adjusted by their handicap time in any Evening 10 Series event.
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### **Competitions won on Points**

C19	The Road Race League Trophy shall be decided by the club rider accumulating the most points in the Shropshire and South Staffordshire Road Race League. In the event of no points being scored best placing in Overall standings at any of the league events shall decide.
C20	The Cyclo-Cross Trophy shall be decided by club rider accumulating the most points in the West Midlands Cyclo-Cross League. In the event of no points being scored best placing in Overall standings at any of the league events shall decide.
C21	The 10 mile Time Trial Points Trophy shall be awarded to the club rider accumulating the greatest number of points in the club's Evening 10 Series. All events count. Riders shall be awarded 6 for the win, 5 for 2nd, 4, 3, 2 until each finisher shall receive 1 point.
C22	<p>The 10 mile Non-Aero Points Trophy shall be awarded to the club rider accumulating the greatest number of points in the club's Evening 10 Series whilst competing on a non-aero bike. The points shall be awarded separately to the TT Points Trophy. All events count. Riders shall be awarded 6 for the win, 5 for 2nd, 4, 3, 2 until each finisher shall receive 1 point.</p> <p>To qualify:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Rider should not use aero tri-bars,</li> <li>• An aero helmet, whether long or short tailed is not allowed (although a standard one is recommended)</li> <li>• Wheel rim depth must not exceed 2"/50mm.</li> </ul>

### **Competitions won on Distance Covered**

C23	The Audax Trophy shall be decided by the rider who has covered the greatest Audax Kilometres. <b>Because events are running when the presentation takes place the qualifying season shall run from 1st November (of the previous year) to 31st October.</b>
C24	<p>The Sportive Trophy shall be decided by the rider who has covered the greatest combined distance in the following activities:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sportive;</li> <li>• Challenge Ride;</li> <li>• Charity Ride; and</li> <li>• Reliability Rides.</li> </ul> <p>In all circumstances, the rider must be able to evidence completion of the ride (e.g. a medal, certificate, or online result). Personal challenge rides (i.e. LEJOG attempts) will not count towards this Trophy, The Committee shall have final say on counting events on an individual event basis in case of any dispute. <b>Because events are running when the presentation takes place the qualifying season shall run from 1st November (of the previous year) to 31st October.</b></p>

### **Competitions won by Vote**

C25	The Mick Jeggo Clubman Trophy shall be awarded to the club member adjudged to have made the largest contribution towards the club during the year. All members shall be eligible to vote, the member receiving the largest number of votes shall win.
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
